Course Title: Canadian Firearms Registry Online: A Tool for Officer Safety

Delivery Method: Online

Course Description:

The Canadian Firearms Registry Online (CFRO) is an indispensable tool for frontline policing and law enforcement. CFRO provides immediate access to firearms licence information, licence status, and firearms registration information in the Canadian Firearms Information System (CFIS), thus preparing officers for more effective responses to calls involving, or potentially involving, firearms. In addition to improving the safety of officers and the public, the CFRO system is important in the investigation of firearms-related crimes and the identification of lost or stolen firearms.

The *Canadian Firearms Registry Online: A Tool for Officer Safety* course focuses on query processes within the CFRO system, the various statuses associated with firearms, licences, and certificates and, using scenario-based exercises, instructs learners on how to interpret query results.

Evaluation Strategy

This course contains two forms of evaluation—practice activities and a final assessment.

Each practice activity provides the means for the learner to self assess, without scoring or tracking, in order to provide an environment to discover from mistakes and perfect their performance.

The final assessment provides a scorable/trackable function that assesses the learner on their overall knowledge gain. The final assessment serves two functions: it provides the learner with a pragmatic utilization of the knowledge; and provides data to the learner's organization so that it can provide the learner with additional remediation, or identify areas in the content that require critical attention and improvement.
