

Eligibility Criteria

The Canadian Police Knowledge Network's F. Darren Smith Award of Excellence recognizes individuals who are making a significant impact on police professional development in Canada. Nominations are open to all sworn and civilian members of the Canadian police community, including individuals employed by police services, police training academies or colleges, and / or related organizations involved in police professional development.

Nominees must have demonstrated one or more of the following in the field of police professional development:

- Exceptional leadership
- Visionary thinking
- Strong dedication
- Notable innovation

Documents Required

The following documents must be submitted with the application form:

- One (1) completed nomination form
- One (1) nomination letter outlining why the nominee should be considered for the award and what criteria they fit.
- One (1) letter of reference from an individual who can speak to the nominee's contributions and impact made to police professional development.
