TIMELINE



November 2018

City of Surrey proposed change in policing from contract RCMP to own municipal police service in 2018, civilian transition team formed to begin transition process



August 2020

The Surrey Police Board established Surrey Police Service in August 2020.



June 2020

The Province of BC established the Surrey Police Board in 2020.



November 2021

The three levels of government, SPS, and the RCMP are implementing this phased policing transition. The transition started in November 2021 and is moving forward.

ABOUT SPS

Surrey Police Union represents SPS officers; CUPE 402 represents SPS civilian employees.

Surrey Police Union ratified its first collective agreement in 2022.

Over 300 police officers and civilian employees have been hired.

~150 SPS officers have been deployed into policing operations, with additional deployments every two months.

Currently have 14 SPS Recruits with SPS Field Trainers in Block II training
(deployed frontline training environment)

BUILDING A NEW TRAINING UNIT


Challenges:

- Lack of training facilities
- Limited internal resources
- No systems, workflows, or programs for managing or tracking training
- Hiring exempt police officers from across Canada: training records
- BC PPS requirements + RCMP Training requirements

Decisions made early:

- Reset training for all exempt officers during Onboarding 6-weeks
- Establish CPKN learning portal for SPS



Advanced Internet Child Exploitation
Cost: \$ 6990 The internet is used by criminals involved in child exploitation, investigation of these crimes develop rapidly and include missing and murdered children. This course provides the knowledge and tools necessary to combat offences related to internet child exploitation. The course provides experienced child internet exploitation investigators with the tools and knowledge to conduct proactive online investigations.
Registration: Closed Course

Canadian Internet Child Exploitation Course
Cost: \$ 6240 This course provides the knowledge, tools and resources to apply Canadian law when investigating Internet-related child sexual exploitation offences. It examines traditional investigative techniques, how to use the Internet as an investigative tool to collect evidence and how to prepare search warrants, search for evidence, and interview suspects. The course focuses on the importance of having standard practices that help reduce bad case law and facilitate inter-agency cooperation during investigations. Hands-on practice exercises and scenarios are used throughout the course.
